# Family History Exploration Activity: Inspired by "Beyond the Bright Sea"

## Activity Overview

In Lauren Wolk's novel "Beyond the Bright Sea," the main character Crow explores her own origins and family history. This activity will help you and your family discover and share your own family's unique story.

## Materials Needed

- Family photo albums
- Notebook or journal
- Pen or pencil
- Optional: Audio recording device or smartphone (to save the audio while you write)

## Activity Steps

## 1. Family Story Gathering

- Invite 2-3 family members from different generations to participate
- Choose a comfortable setting like your living room or kitchen
- Prepare a list of interview questions about family history

## 2. Interview Questions

Choose 3-5 questions to ask family members:

- Where did our family originally come from?
- What stories have been passed down through generations?
- What challenges did our ancestors overcome?
- What family traditions are most important to us?
- Can you tell me about a memorable family moment?

### 3. Documentation

- Take notes during the conversation
- Consider recording the conversation (with family permission)
- Draw a simple family tree together

## 4. Reflection Connection

Write a short paragraph connecting your family's story to themes in "Beyond the Bright Sea":

- How does understanding your origins feel?
- What similarities do you see between Crow's journey and your family's history?
