WHAT IS A CHARTER SCHOOL?


Charter Schools...

- Open to the Public;
- Publicly Funded;
- Tuition-Free;
- Must Comply with Both State and Federal Educational Mandates;
- Participate in State Testing;
- Employ Credentialed Teachers.







CALIFORNIA COLLEGE ADMISSIONS (2025)

- For UC enrollment, the system saw record-high student numbers for Fall 2025 (over 301,000 students), with continued growth in California resident undergraduates, continuing a trend expected to grow further as the system aims for 1% yearly increases.
- California Residents: California resident undergraduates also hit record numbers, with over 200,000 for Fall 2025, marking the 10th consecutive year of growth, according to UC San Diego Guardian and University of California.
- UC San Diego (UCSD) saw record enrollment for Fall 2025, reaching 45,087 matriculated students, part of a record high for the entire UC system, with strong interest from California residents. The university admitted around 38,460 first-year students from over 136,000 applications for Fall 2025.
- SDSU saw record enrollment for Fall 2025, with combined headcount exceeding 41,000 for the first time, including Global Campus, nearing 43,000 total.
- California's State University enrollment for 2026 is marked by the new Senate Bill 640, introducing automatic admission for qualified high school seniors into 16 California State University (CSU) campuses, with full statewide rollout for Fall 2027.
